

The result of this change is that service providers will be required to submit certifications on paper for each and every individual request. This change may require thousands of individual certifications, which would increase the service providers' costs significantly due to the time it will take to prepare and sign each certification. The Commission has provided no reason for this change, which will increase the burden on service providers. Absent some basis for the change, Sprint strongly urges the Commission to retain the current certification process to avoid additional burden on the E-rate service providers.
